**Division:** Nursing

Reports to: Contact Tracer Supervisor

Position: This position is temporary to assist MCPH with the COVID-19 response. The position is for six months but

could end prior to that time period due to funding or needs of the department.

Hours: Part-time, 20-40 hours depending on workload. Some weekend and evening hours may be required

**Salary:** \$13.14 - \$20.55

Location: This job will be performed mostly remotely – telecommuting from your residence. There may be a need to

travel occasionally to conduct in-person interviews

Project Duration: up to 6 months

### JOB RESPONSIBILITIES:

Under general direction of the Contact Tracer Supervisor, the Contact Tracer acts as a "disease detective" and will gather critical information from Miami County residents diagnosed with COVID-19 by identifying and calling their contacts. The Contact Tracer is responsible for:

- Calling contacts of newly diagnosed cases
- Communicating with contacts in a professional and empathetic manner
- Collecting and recording information on symptoms into a database
- Providing contacts with approved information about Ohio quarantine procedures, and if appropriate, refer them to testing according to protocol
- Following a script to inform contacts about the importance of quarantine and what to do if symptoms develop
- Using a telephone, computer and electronic equipment to capture data
- Maintaining daily contact with supervisor
